

Al-Hasa Healthcare Services List

Below is a list of the services currently provided at JHAH:

PRIMARY CARE:

- Primary care GP Clinics
- Pediatric Clinics
- Special Primary Care-led Clinics:
- Physical exam
- Smoking cessation
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy Clinic
- Intra-Articular Injections
- Cryotherapy
- Average census in the Primary Care Clinics: 300 patients per day
- Some patients are referred for consultation in AHHC specialty clinics or admission to Al Hasa inpatient wards or referred to DHC inpatient. On average these total 260 per month
- Adult Diabetic clinic runs every day and sees an average of 55 patients per week
- The TB clinic sees an average of 20 patients per month
- The Foot and Nail Clinic runs twice-weekly and sees an average of 22 patients per week and for that times 3 times/wk.
- Employee Health Clinic is held twice a week and sees an average of 42 patients per month.
- Physical examination CLINIC (nursing visit) runs every Sunday.
- Cryotherapy clinic was commenced in September 2013. The clinic operates on Monday afternoon 1230 – 1530.
- Clinic commenced in September 2013 for joint injections and sees approximately 10 cases/clinic
- A (NCM) clinic runs every day to serve the patients since December, 2016.
- A Diabetic EYE screening clinic started May, 2017 two days per WEEK (Sunday and Tuesday).
- Pediatric Diabetic clinic once a month.
