

# Quarantine and Test Protocols for Travelers Arriving to KSA

## \*Definition of a COVID-19 immunized individual

### Citizens and residents of Saudi Arabia

Health status in the Tawakkalna mobile application must appear as **Immune**:

- **Immune** - Have received two doses of a two-dose MOH approved vaccine
- **Immune by first dose** - Provided that 14 days have passed since vaccination
- **Immune by recovery** - Provided that no more than six months have passed since the individual has recovered from COVID-19

**Non-citizens, non-residents, and first time visitors**, whose information does not appear in the Tawakkalna mobile application, are considered COVID-19 immunized if they present an immunization certificate issued or approved by the official health authorities in the country they are departing from, stating that they have completed the COVID-19 vaccination with one of the following authorized vaccines by the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia:

- Pfizer-BionTech (two doses)
- Oxford-AstraZeneca (two doses)
- Moderna (two doses)
- Johnson & Johnson (single dose)

For these individuals to be considered immunized, at least 14 days must have passed between receiving the last dose (the second in a two-dose vaccine or the first in a single-dose vaccine) and arriving to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
